Dorothy Farrer's Spring Wood



i The reserve will be closed from Sunday 10th October until Tuesday 12th October for essential maintenance to the Purple Orchid. The reserve will be open again on Wednesday morning as normal.

A sizeable and varied woodland, where plantations of conifers contrast with old coppiced hornbeams.

The boundary of this woodland is clearly marked on a map of 1790 although it may not always have been a woodland. The northern part of the wood is the oldest and varies from old hornbeam coppice, which is now very mature, to mixed woodland of ash and field maple. Aspen has become more abundant in recent years and stands out when its leaves quiver in a breeze.
